### **CHARLES WISNIEWSKI BIO**

As President and CEO of Teddy's Transportation System, Inc., Charles Wisniewski focuses on growing his family business while continuing to exceed his customers' high standards. An industry leader in the identification and adoption of innovative technologies that enhance service delivery, he has achieved a level of growth that ranked Teddy's on the inaugural *Inc. Magazine* 5000 Fastest Growing Companies list in 2006 and on each successive annual list since. In 2007 the company was runner-up in both the *Limo Digest* Operator of the Year Contest and the Connecticut Family Business of the Year award competition. Teddy's was recently selected as a finalist in the *LCT Magazine* 2011 Operator of the Year competition, the industry's most prestigious award.

Mr. Wisniewski's active involvement in the limousine industry includes numerous speaking engagements and affiliations. In 1985 he presented at the National Limousine Association's (NLA) second conference, and in 1990 he was elected Secretary of the NLA Board of Directors. In 1993 (at the age of 31), he was elected President of the NLA Board of Directors, and he still has the distinction of being the organization's youngest-ever president.

In 1985 Mr. Wisniewski, his father, Ted, and about eight Connecticut limousine company owners co-founded Limousine Operators of Connecticut (LOC). In 1989 the father-son team initiated and helped coordinate the first-ever sting of gypsy livery operators - an enforcement that continues today. Over the years, Mr. Wisniewski has helped to grow the LOC, eventually helping merge it with the New England Livery Association (NELA). He has also initiated and hosted meetings of the Southern District of the New England Livery Association.

As well, he is a regular speaker at LCT International, the premiere global EXPO for the Limousine & Chartered Transportation industry. A frequent contributor to LCT Magazine, he has recently been asked to serve as a regular columnist.

Mr. Wisniewski has addressed the Westchester/Fairfield regional chapters of the National Business Travel Association (NBTA) and Meeting Professionals International, as well as a number of parent-teacher groups. He is a tireless advocate for industry safety standards.

Mr. Wisniewski is the oldest offspring of Teddy's founders, Ted and Shelley Wisniewski. In 2009, full ownership was transitioned to Charles and his sister, Linda Bento, and brother, Ted Wisniewski, Jr.
